



# **BE FEARLESS FOUNDATION**

## ***Parent / Guardian Referral Release & Liability Waiver***

**Be Fearless Foundation acts solely as a referral organization and does not provide, supervise, or control any services.**

### **1. Acknowledgment of Referral Role**

This section exists to clearly define that BFF's role is limited to connecting families with qualified third-party providers. BFF does not provide or control any services, which ensures transparency and proper accountability.

### **2. Independent Providers**

This section clarifies that all services are delivered by independent organizations. This is important so that responsibility for care, training, and outcomes remains with the provider, not BFF.

### **3. Assumption of Risk**

This section ensures that parents understand there are inherent risks in both physical training and emotional development services. Participation is voluntary and accepted with full awareness of these risks.

### **4. Release of Liability**

This section protects BFF from being held responsible for outcomes, injuries, or dissatisfaction related to services it does not control.

### **5. No Guarantees**

This section explains that while BFF aims to help each child, outcomes vary and cannot be guaranteed.

### **6. Funding Acknowledgment**

This section clarifies that any financial support is based on donations and may vary. It ensures expectations are realistic while still emphasizing support for the child.

### **7. Information Sharing & Coordination**

This section exists to allow limited, purposeful communication between partner organizations to better support your child. For example, a mental health provider may share general information about the type of bullying your child is experiencing (such as confidence issues, social challenges, or bullying

patterns) with a martial arts or training facility so they can better support your child's development. Only information relevant to the bullying or developmental needs will be shared. No sensitive personal, medical, or unrelated information will be disclosed without consent. Each referred establishment will also receive a copy of this signed waiver.

## 8. Social Media & Public Communications

This section helps ensure that feedback is directed appropriately and fairly. BFF exists to help your child access opportunities, not to deliver services directly. Parents are encouraged to contact BFF first with concerns so we can help resolve issues and continue supporting your child.

## 9. Final Acknowledgment

This section reinforces that BFF is strictly a referral organization and that all services and outcomes are the responsibility of the provider. This understanding is essential for participation.
